- 100% Job Assistance in Japan

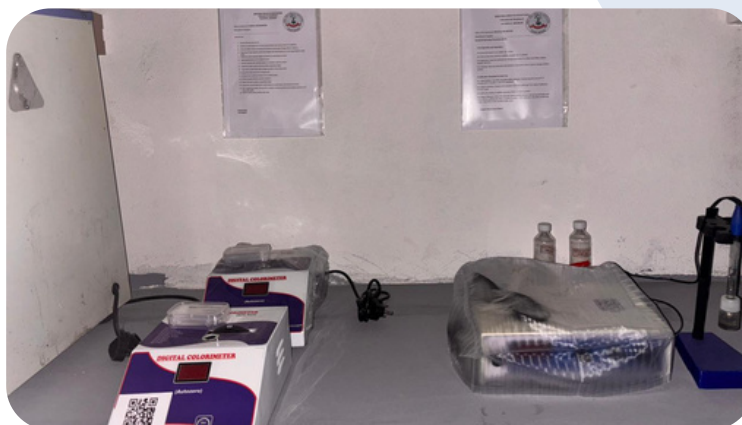


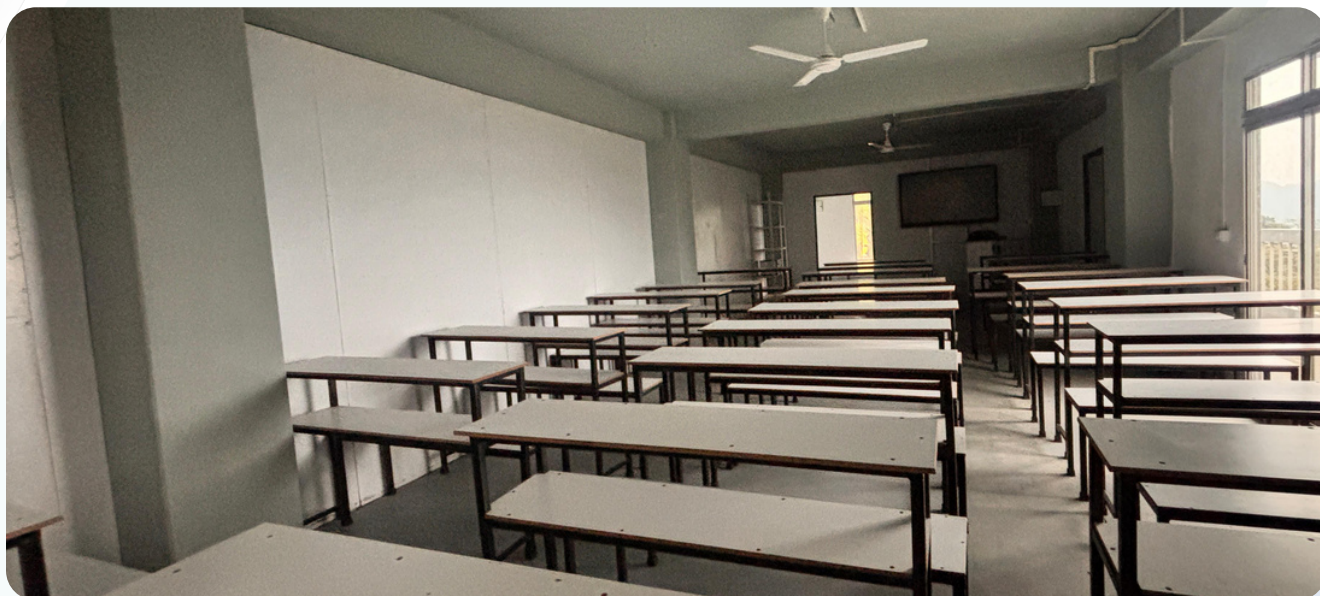
ACADEMIC FOCUS

EXAMINATION THEORY

Sessional Examinations

There shall be two or more periodic sessional (internal assessment) examinations during each academic year. The duration of the sessional exam shall be 90 minutes. The highest aggregate of any two performances shall form the basis of calculating the sessional marks.

Final Board / University Examinations

The final theory examinations should be conducted by the examining authority (Board / University). The duration of the final examination shall be 3 hours.

EXAMINATION PRACTICAL

Sessional Examinations

There shall be two or more periodic sessional (internal assessment) practical examinations during each academic year. The duration of the sessional exam shall be three hours. The highest aggregate of any two performances shall form the basis of calculating the sessional marks.

Final Board / University Examinations

The final practical examinations should be conducted by the examining authority (Board / University). The duration of the final examination shall be 3 hours.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **75% attendance** is required to sit in Sessions and Final Examination.
2. Fees should be paid on time. One should inform the authority before the deadline if unable to pay fees on time, defaulters will have to pay a late fee of Rs.30 and will increase by Rs. 10/- everyday
3. Before taking a leave, **one should inform the concerned authority by providing a leave letter**, mentioning valid reason/reasons for the absence, on the date of joining. Any absence without leave will have to be made good by a fine of Rs. 100.
4. Absence without leave for 5 or more days without any information will be considered as forfeiture of admission.
5. Any student who could not wear full uniform for any reason has to inform the teachers before entering the classroom.
6. Use of Cell phones is restricted in the classroom unless it is suggested by the faculty. If one is found using cell phones during class and get caught, it will be given back the next day.
7. One should maintain punctuality by reaching the institution at 9:45 am.
8. Seat taken cannot be withdrawn without replacing it initially or the Institution could incur an amount of fee for the rest of the running course.
9. Cigarettes, Gudkhas, Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco and any other intoxicants are strictly prohibited within the Institute premises. Anyone carrying or eating these within the premises will be fined Rs.100.
10. Students are not allowed to wear or even carry any jewellerys or accessories in the institution. If caught, items would not be given back.
11. Hair should not be too long or too short for boys. Girls should tie their hair neatly with a black band. Other fancy bands or hair clips are not allowed.
